

Amherst Historical Society Continuing Education Scholarship

2024 Scholarship Fund Guidelines

The Amherst Historical Society collects, preserves, records, interprets and educates those interested in the rich history of the Amherst area, including its sandstone history in Lorain County, Ohio, and utilizes the Amherst Sandstone Village and Quigley Museum to keep history alive.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Applicant must submit the following items, stapled together, in the following order:

- 1. A completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly).
- 2. A personal statement that is two pages or less, double-spaced and typed. Include information that would help the Amherst Historical Society know you and understand your eligibility or need, i.e. how you are financing your training/education, previous work experience, reasons for choosing your career goals, challenges in your life, and plans after graduation.
- 3. A recent high school transcript or high school diploma.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. The deadline to submit completed scholarship applications is Friday, April 12, 2024, at 4pm (no exceptions) to the Amherst Historical Society, 113 South Lake Street, Amherst, OH 44001.
- 2. Applications may be submitted in person or by mail to the address above, or by email to office@amhersthistoricalsociety.org
- 3. If any question does not apply to you in this application, please put N/A in the space.
- 4. You must indicate the scholarship(s) you are applying for in order to be considered.
- 5. Type and print legibly. Illegible applications will not be considered. You may also download a copy of the application online at https://amhersthistoricalsociety.org
- 6. If you are awarded a scholarship, you will be notified before the end of May.
- 7. All scholarship awards must be claimed by December 31, 2024.
